During the week participants will start the day exploring the latest in new technology with professionals in the field. Teens will also work as a team to produce a collective group project. On Friday this collaborative effort will be displayed as well as each individual’s product. Awards are given on the final day. Family and friends are invited.

Lunch is provided by the library each day.
