Duty Location: Official Duty Station is the Dredge Hurley, position requires (non-TDY) travel with the Hurley, shift work, and mandatory overtime.

Work Schedule: Full-Time

Travel Requirement: Temporary Duty Travel is over 5% of the time

Who May Apply: U.S. Citizens

Responsibilities/Duties: Incumbent Serves as a working leader of 2-5 Deckhand positions assigned to the Dredge Hurley. Performs and leads others in work involving the handling and fastening of lines to moor plant and make tows. Sets a pace that assures a steady productive output by the group. Distributes tools and materials to workers and is responsible for the care and storage of equipment. Keeps vessel's gear and rigging in good working order. Explains and demonstrates deckhand tasks and provides other immediate guidance to the group. Passes on instructions received from supervisor. Make suggestions and recommendations regarding work methods, performance of individual workers, etc. Explains and assures compliance with safety, conduct, and housekeeping rules and regulations

Schedule: During the dredging season, typically May through November, all Hurley crew members, including this position, work a 15 days on/6 days off schedule, with the work period beginning and ending on Wednesdays. On the 15 work days, employees remain on the Dredge Hurley and are provided meals and lodging. This position works a 12 hour shift, and may rotate between day and night shifts. During the non-dredging season, the crew works day shift only, with the vessel based at Ensley Engineer Yard, Memphis, TN, on either a 5-day/8-hour or 4-day/10-hr schedule. During the dredging season, the Dredge Hurley will work in widespread locations in the Mississippi River, including up to 120 days in the vicinity of Baton Rouge, LA.

Qualifications Requirements: For all qualified employees currently within the Memphis District, must possess/obtain current TWIC. Must pass physical exam and drug screening test if selected for position.

Conditions of Employment:

- Must meet suitability for Federal employment
- Physical and Drug Test required
- Will be required to provide proof of U.S. Citizenship
- Male applicants born after December 31, 1959 must complete a Pre-employment Certification Statement for Selective Service Registration
- Personnel security investigation required
- [Reasonable accommodation](#) is available to qualified employees with disabilities
- Two-year probationary period is required.
