Duty Location: Official Duty Station is the Motor Vessel Mississippi, position requires (non-TDY) travel with the Motor Vessel Mississippi, shift work, and mandatory overtime.

Work Schedule: Full-Time, Seasonal

Appointment Type: Permanent

Travel Requirement: Temporary Duty Travel is 5% of the time

Who May Apply: U.S. Citizens

Responsibilities/Duties: Incumbent serves as a Deckhand Leaderman on the Motor Vessel Mississippi serving as working leader of (4-8) employees in accomplishing deckhand & labor work. Passes on to other workers instructions received from supervisor, and starts work (e.g., by assigning the immediate tasks to be performed by individual members of the group led). Works along with other workers, setting the pace performing a variety of work involved in the operation, maintenance, and repair of the deck and general housekeeping functions on towboats, barges, or other floating plant vessels. Official Duty Station is the Motor Vessel Mississippi, position requires (non-TDY) travel with the Motor Vessel Mississippi, shift work, and mandatory overtime.

Schedule: During the season, all Motor Vessel Mississippi crew members, including this position, work a 15 days on/6 days off schedule, with the work period beginning and ending on Wednesdays. On the 15 work days, employees remain on the Motor Vessel Mississippi and are provided meals and lodging. This position works a 12 hour shift, and may rotate between day and night shifts. During the non-season, the crew works day shift only, with the vessel based at Ensley Engineer Yard, Memphis, TN, on either a 5-day/8-hour or 4-day/10-hr schedule. During the season, the vessel will work in widespread locations in the Mississippi River. This is a permanent seasonal position, seasonal workers are normally placed in non-pay status (laid off) for part of the non-season. This is a full-time permanent seasonal position. Seasonal signifies an annually, recurring period of employment of less than 2087 hours per year. During non-work periods you will be placed in a non-duty, non-pay status.

Qualifications Requirements: For all qualified employees currently within the Memphis District, must obtain and maintain TWIC. Must pass physical exam and drug screening test if selected for position.

Conditions of Employment:

- Must meet suitability for Federal employment
- Physical and Drug Test required
- Will be required to provide proof of U.S. Citizenship
- Male applicants born after December 31, 1959 must complete a Pre-employment Certification Statement for Selective Service Registration
- Personnel security investigation required
- [Reasonable accommodation](#) is available to qualified employees with disabilities
- Lifting requirement is 40 lbs.
- Two year probationary period is required.
