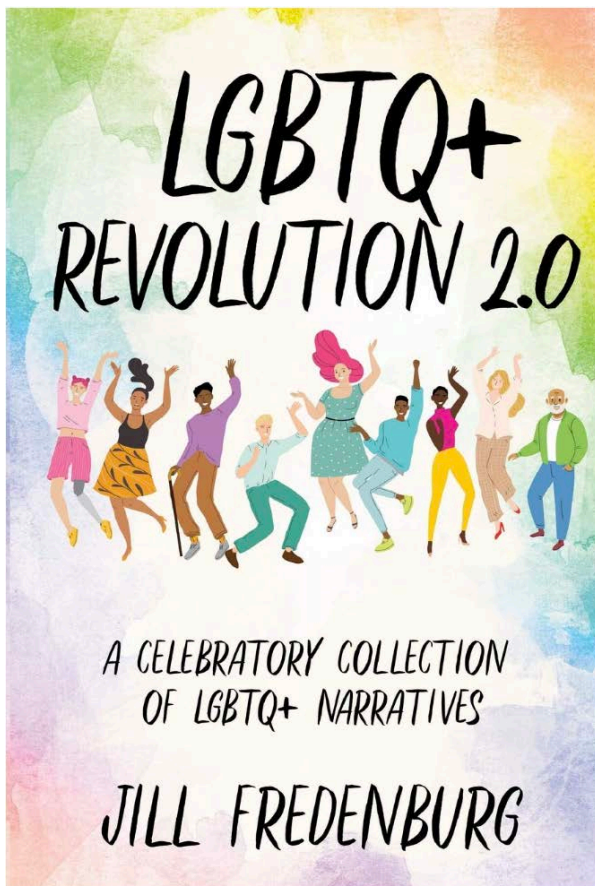


Jill Fredenburg
