

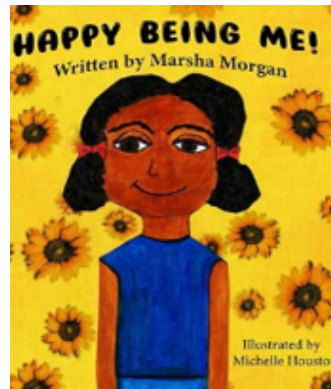
# Marsha Morgan
