D. Terry Yarbrough, a native Memphian, launched his police career on March 4, 1968, with the Memphis Police Department in Memphis, Tennessee. As a Black American, his law enforcement career resulted in challenging lessons learned: *what to do, how to do, and what not to do*. Yarbrough served 16 years as a Memphis police officer and 28 years as a deputy sheriff in Shelby County, Tennessee, earning the rank of Captain.
