Giving your student access to Memphis Public Libraries is as simple as completing this form! With a new STUDENT card, your child can enjoy books and magazines from any of our 18 locations as well as our huge digital collection of e-books and more. We encourage parents, grandparents, and/or legal guardians to sign up for a library card as well when you bring your child to the library!

Your Online Access

- Visit www.memphislibrary.org and search all that is available! Once your child's card has been approved and issued, you will be able to click on the "Accounts" tab to log in and review your child's account using their library card number and the last four digits of it as their PIN.
- The "Virtual" tab on our website will take you to all our online material and databases, free to all cardholders.
- Our digital collection of e-books and audiobooks can also be accessed by downloading the free Libby app to any smart device and logging in with your card number and PIN.

Your Local Branch

- In addition to our virtual and digital services, a STUDENT card entitles your child to check out up to three physical books, magazines or audiobooks at a time for up to four months from any of our 18 locations.
- They will be able to enjoy free Wi-Fi and computer access at every location by signing in with their library card, as well as printing materials for school assignments or personal use for \$0.20 a page.
- Each branch has free activities, programs, classes and events throughout the year for all ages!

Your Child's Account

- Library cards are good for two years. Renewal is free. Simply bring in proof of MSCS enrollment or proof of address.
- Our library is fee-and-fine-free. There are no overdue or checkout fees associated with any of our materials.
- Student cards cannot check out DVDs or CDs.
- Lost or damaged items (beyond what we can repair) will accrue a fine equal to the cost of item. Accounts with fines of \$15 and above will not be allowed to check out other materials. We will renew "lost" items twice to give you time to locate them. If found, there is no fine. Just bring it back!

Your Choice

- If your child loves to read, you can upgrade their account to a REGULAR account. They will be entitled to 25 items at a time for a period of three weeks, and they will have access to DVDs and CDs.
